If I join, will I be forced to volunteer?

No. You can choose to volunteer as much as you like; one event, all events or not at all. We respect your time and are grateful for the help.

I work or have other full-time commitments, so I can't help out at school events.

That's okay. Joining the P&C can be a great way to maintain links to the school even if you are unable to attend events.

I don't have any experience / know how to do these things.

Neither did we when we started. Don't worry we can show you what we already know and if we don't know the answer, we will work it out together.

The P&C already have lots of members, they don't need me.

We do need you! Our P&C currently has about 11 active members, compared with approximately 300 students attending our school.

Each member is highly valued and brings diversity and new opinions to the group. There is so much that we believe we can achieve, but we just don't have enough people. So if you want to help make improvements to the school community and have ideas, why not join the P&C and make it happen.

What is the difference between a Member and a Volunteer?

The main differences are that a member can vote on Policy decisions, be invited to sit on a school selection committee and apply for grants to benefit the school.

The Executive positions (President, Secretary, Treasurer and Coordinator Positions) are to attend every P&C meeting, while general members are encouraged to attend it is not a requirement.
